Thank you for choosing Aledo's Rhubarb Festival to exhibit your Crafts/Antiques/Flea Market items. We look forward to the Festival being a huge success once again this year. The following are guidelines which we hope will make the Festival run smoothly for everyone.

- **Booths may be set up from 5:30-7:30pm Thursday, June 1st or 6:30 am on Friday, June 2nd.** (for a Saturday only set up) Please wait until **after** 4 pm to ease congestion; due to the fact that the event runs until that time-Thank you! **Or 6:30 am to 9 am Saturday, June 3rd.**  
\*\*\*\*\*Exhibitor vehicles may be parked and unloaded in the parking spaces on the North side of Central Park Parking lot, & Public Parking lots. Before unloading, please check in with a volunteer from Aledo Main Street. Volunteers will be located at the West end of the Parking Lot and in the Aledo Main Street Booth located in Central Park. All Aledo Main Street volunteers will be wearing hot pink shirts stating Volunteer.
- Vendors may not use mobile homes or trailers as their craft booth
- All participants are solely responsible for their own merchandise and proper insurance coverage on themselves and their property. The festival assumes no liability for breakage, theft or damage to entrant's property or self.
- Each booth space will be 10'X16'. All participants are responsible for providing their own tables, set-up and coverings for inclement weather. Please cover all tables for a neat display.
- There will not be electricity available.
- Exhibitor is responsible to pick up and clean the general area assigned to them before leaving the location.
- There will be no refunds issued for this event **for any reason.**

**Please mail in proof of insurance prior to the event; list Aledo Main Street as a certificate holder.  
This must be completed in order to comply with our insurance provider requests.**
