Dear “TREES IN THE PARK” Decorator,

It’s time to think about decorating Christmas trees in Aledo’s Central Park! You or your organization volunteered to decorate a tree in the past and we hope you’ll join “Trees In The Park” again this year. You are welcome to sponsor your own tree and pay the \$32 fee if you wish, but you certainly don’t have to do so. If you know a business or individual who would be willing to sponsor your tree, please let us know; otherwise, we will match you up with a sponsor. As a decorator, your only investment would be for lights and decorations plus your time and imagination.

This year’s theme for Trees In The Park is **“Polar Express”**. We plan to have the trees set up in Central Park on Saturday afternoon, November 25th. Signs by each tree will show the names of both the sponsor and the decorator. The trees can be decorated any time from that Sunday, November 26th, up until 4 p.m. on Friday, December 1st, prior to the Christmas Walk.

Judging will take place at 5 p.m. on Friday, December 1st, during Aledo’s “Holly Days” Christmas Walk. Judges will award points for overall appearance, originality and use of the theme **“Polar Express”**. Ballots will also be taken during the Christmas Walk for the “People’s Choice” award. The **decorators** will be awarded cash prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place and for the People’s Choice.
